	Millenium Asparagus	Produces high-quality spears that are tender and delicious. Medium to large stalks. Likes well drained, sunny soil.

	Blue Ray - Blueberry	Highbush variety. Will grow 5' tall and harvest in August. Should be planted with other varieties.								
	Bonus - Blueberry	Highbush variety. Fruit is extra large. Mid season harvest around July 30th. Should be planted with other varieties.								
	Blue Gold - Blueberry	Ripening in late July. Will start bearing fruit in 1 year. Self pollinating.								
	Blue Crop - Blueberry	Produces big clusters of large berries. Ripens in July. Self pollinating.

	Gala Gala Apple	Full red color with deep red striping, allowing harvest in one or two pickings. The finish is very clean.	3/4"							
	Benton Cherry	Self pollinating. Large black sweet cherry	5/8"							
	Coralstar Peach	Holds well on the tree and in storage and does not brown when cut. The tree is hardy and resistant to bacterial spot. Self pollinating.	3/4"							
	Early Redhaven Peach	Self pollinating and ripen in late July. It is heavy-bearing, cold-hardy, and resists leaf spot, and the fruit is spectacular.	3/4"							
	Empress Plum	This large plum has good flavor and eye appeal. It resembles President Plum, with blue skin and amber flesh. President is a good cross pollinator for this variety.	3/4"							
	President Plum	The fruit is oblong in shape with dark blue skin and yellow flesh. Cross pollination required.	3/4"							
	Beurre Danjou Pear	A very high-quality pear ripening in late September. Fruit is light green	3/4"							
Shenandoah Pear	Fruit size is large with traditional sub-acid pear flavor. Blight resistance is good and similar to that of Seckel. Stores well for up to five months.	3/4"
